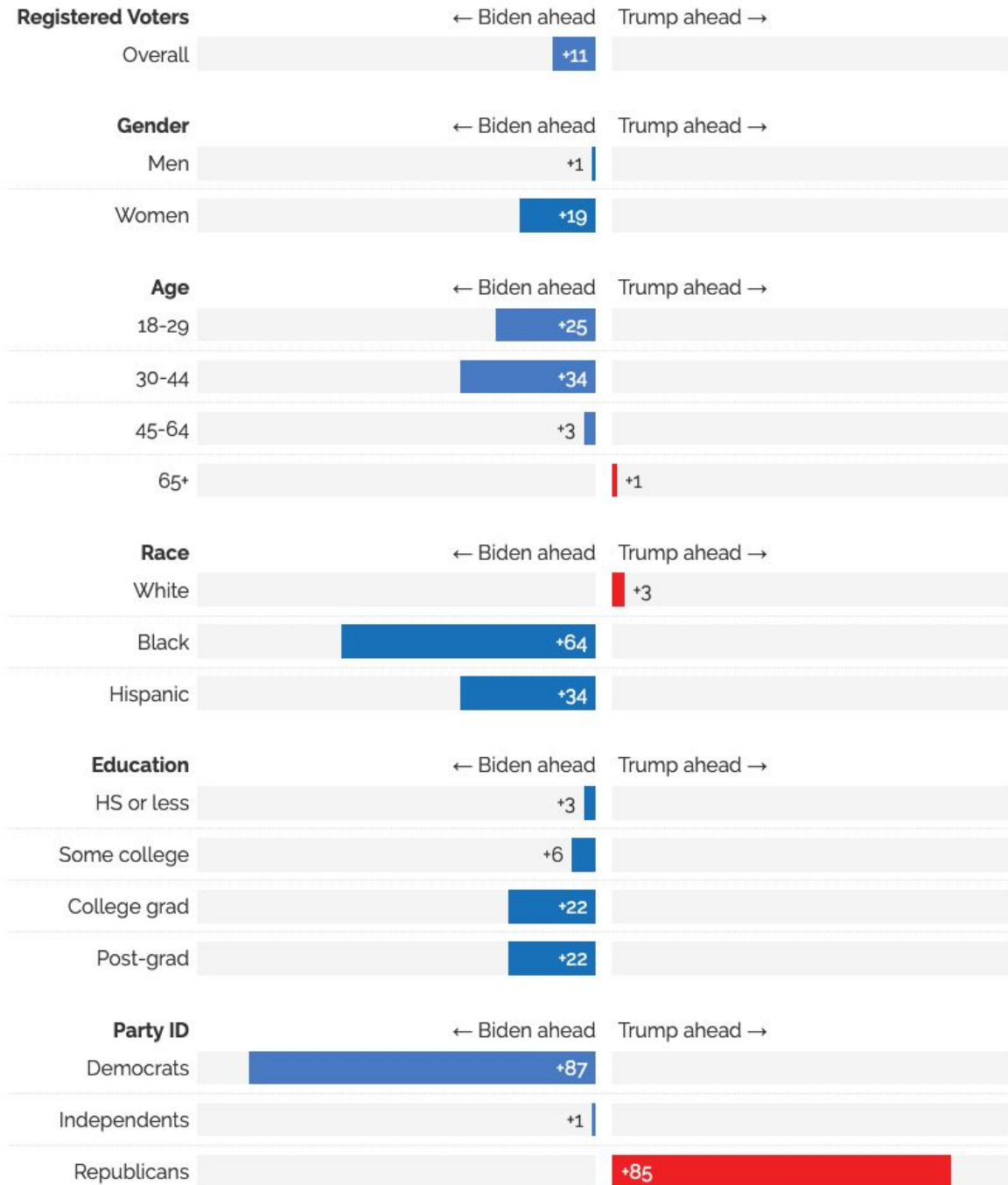

6. In [recent presidential elections](#), Democrats have trailed Republicans in support from males. The last time Democrats got more male support than Republicans was in 2008. Currently, Biden has more male support than Trump. Why do you think that is?
7. Which candidate has more support from their own party?
8. Explain why it is possible that one U.S. presidential candidate could receive more support than another but still lose the election?
9. Describe the three main reasons Biden is winning by so much.
10. Explain how this polling data might impact other elections like the U.S. Senate, U.S. House, and state Governor races.
11. Do you think Biden will win the election and if so do you think Biden will become the next president?

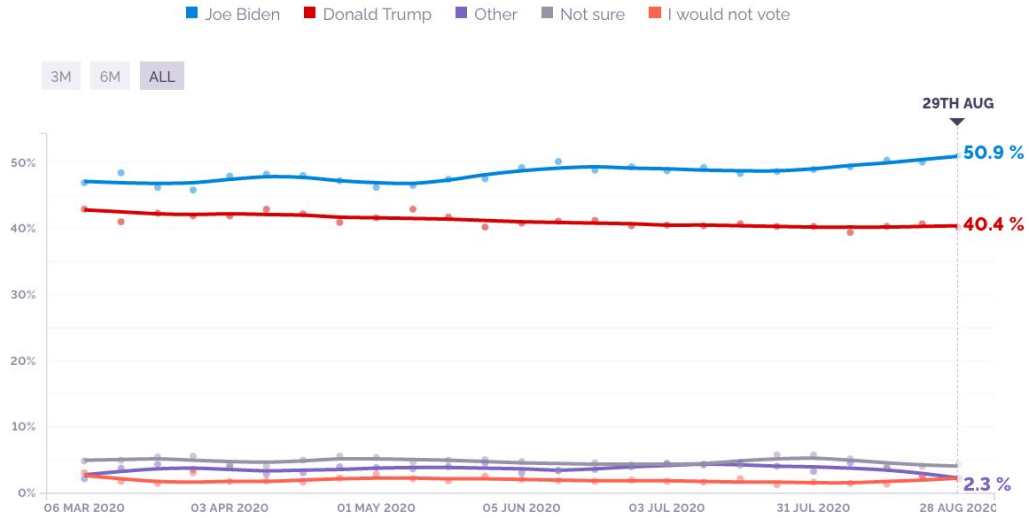
