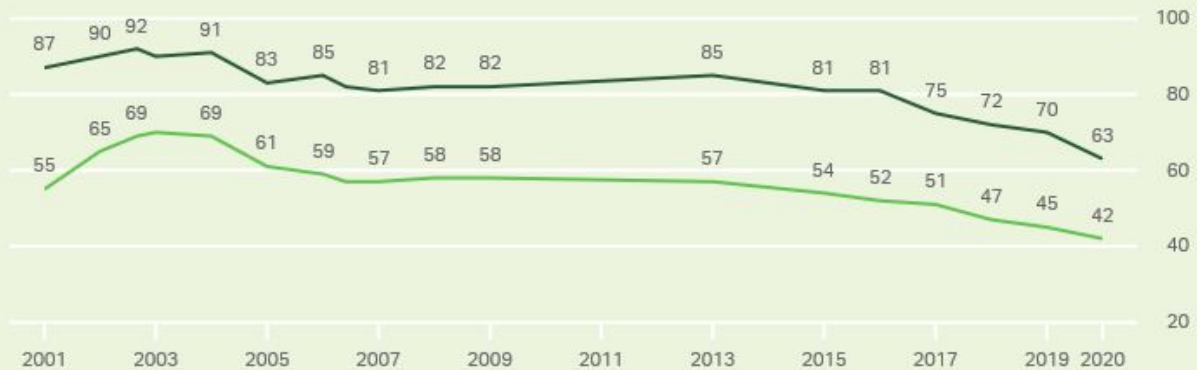


## U.S. Adults' Diminishing Pride in Being American

12. How do demographics impact national pride?\*

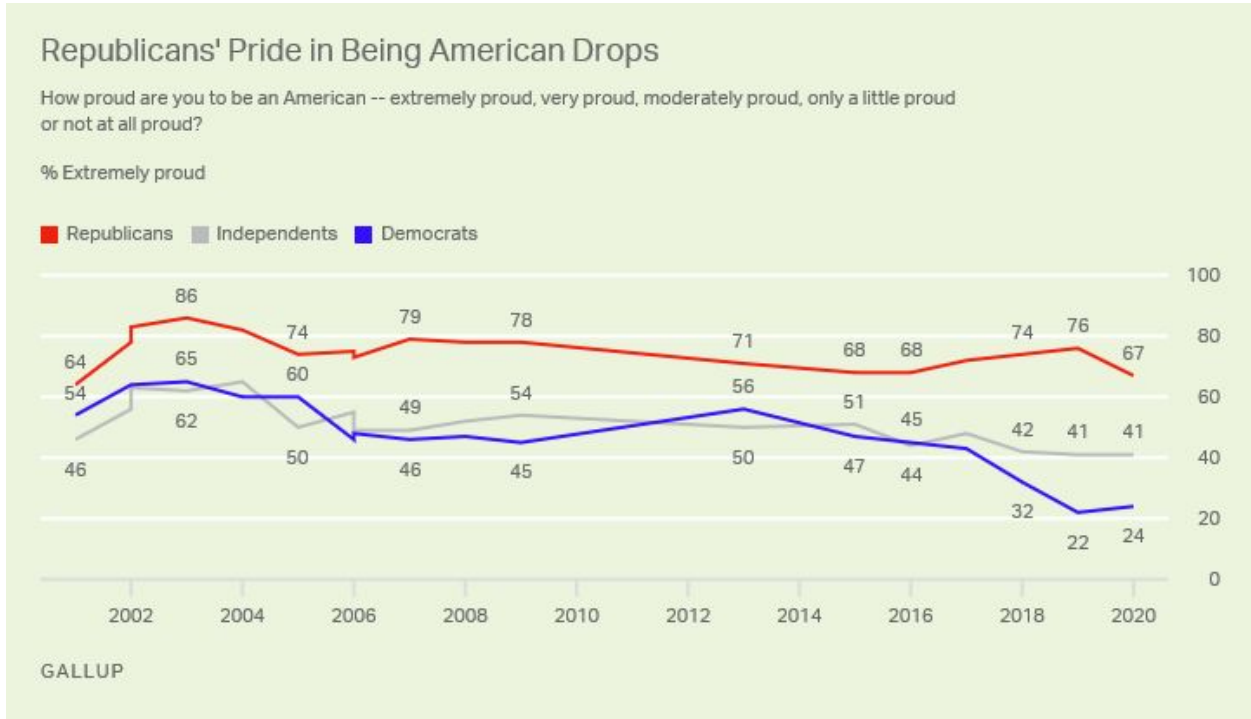
